

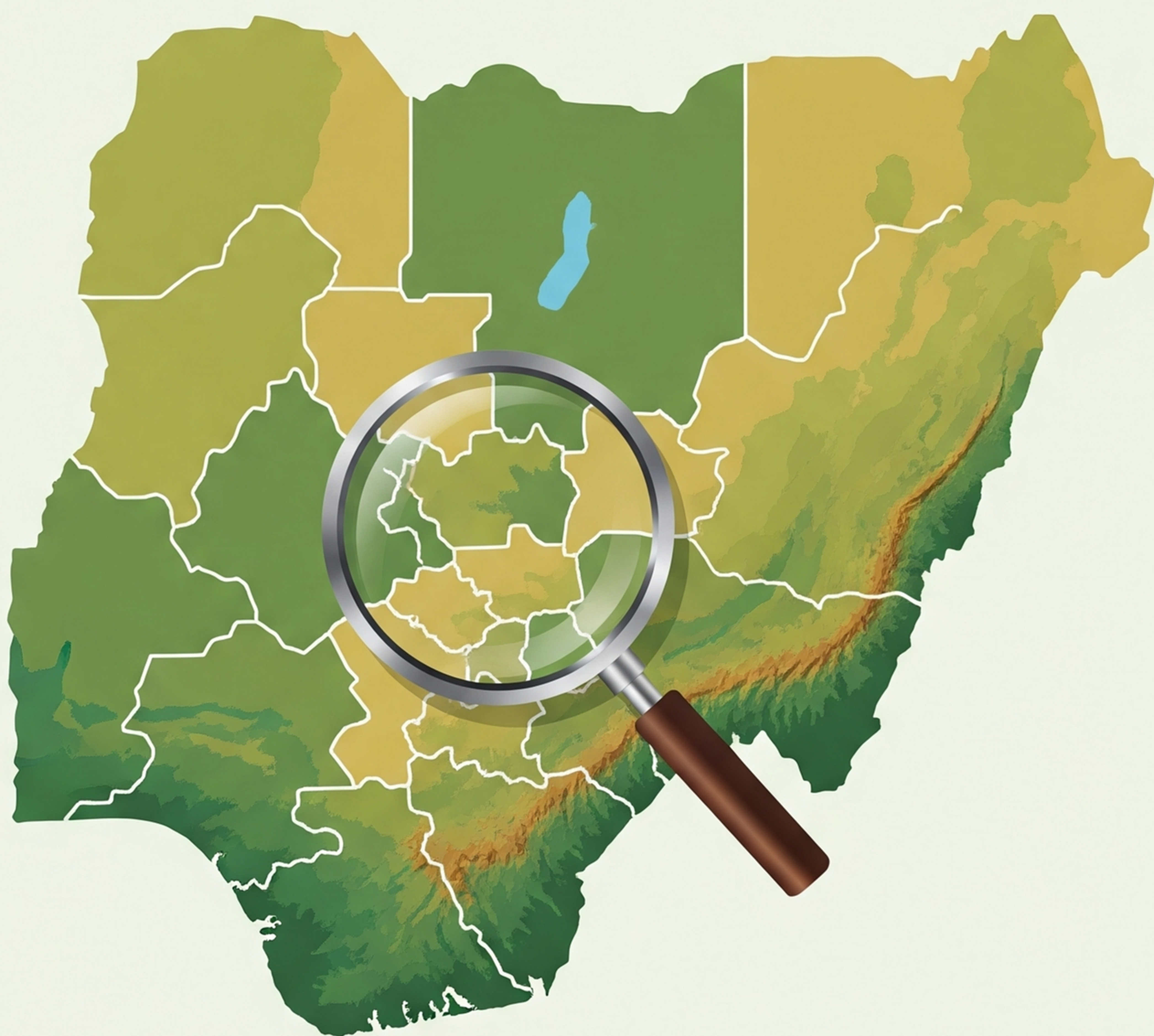

DEFINING FOOD SECURITY



Good food available in sufficient quantities



Access to food through affordability or own production



Proper food utilization for different ages and health needs



Stable food supply and utilization.

These are the steps to ensure

1. Cultivate and consume biofortified and nutrient-dense foods
2. Cultivating varieties of crop-diversification helps to mitigate risks
3. Invest in storage solutions, preservation through drying, especially during the off-season.

What is FBG?



Family Business Garden (FBG) is the process of gaining control over our diet, ensuring organic and fresh food, rich in essential nutrients, is produced for the household's consumption and market.

It is a deliberate way of growing food by utilizing any kind of space around the home.

FBG ensures intentionality and considers sustainability, family nutrition, and income

FBG considers the following:

- Sustainability in soil use: Mostly uses household wastes and livestock wastes for soil amendments.
- Family nutrition, particularly to satisfy therapeutic diets for categories of ages in the household.
- Market availability and income: takes extra harvest to the market to supplement household income.

Does FBG care for the climate?

YES, Family Business Garden helps to reduce the pressure on the environment, as it ensures Regenerative Agricultural Practices, which include recycling of household waste for composting, inorganic fertilizer application in the right specifications, mulching and soil covers, and no tillage.

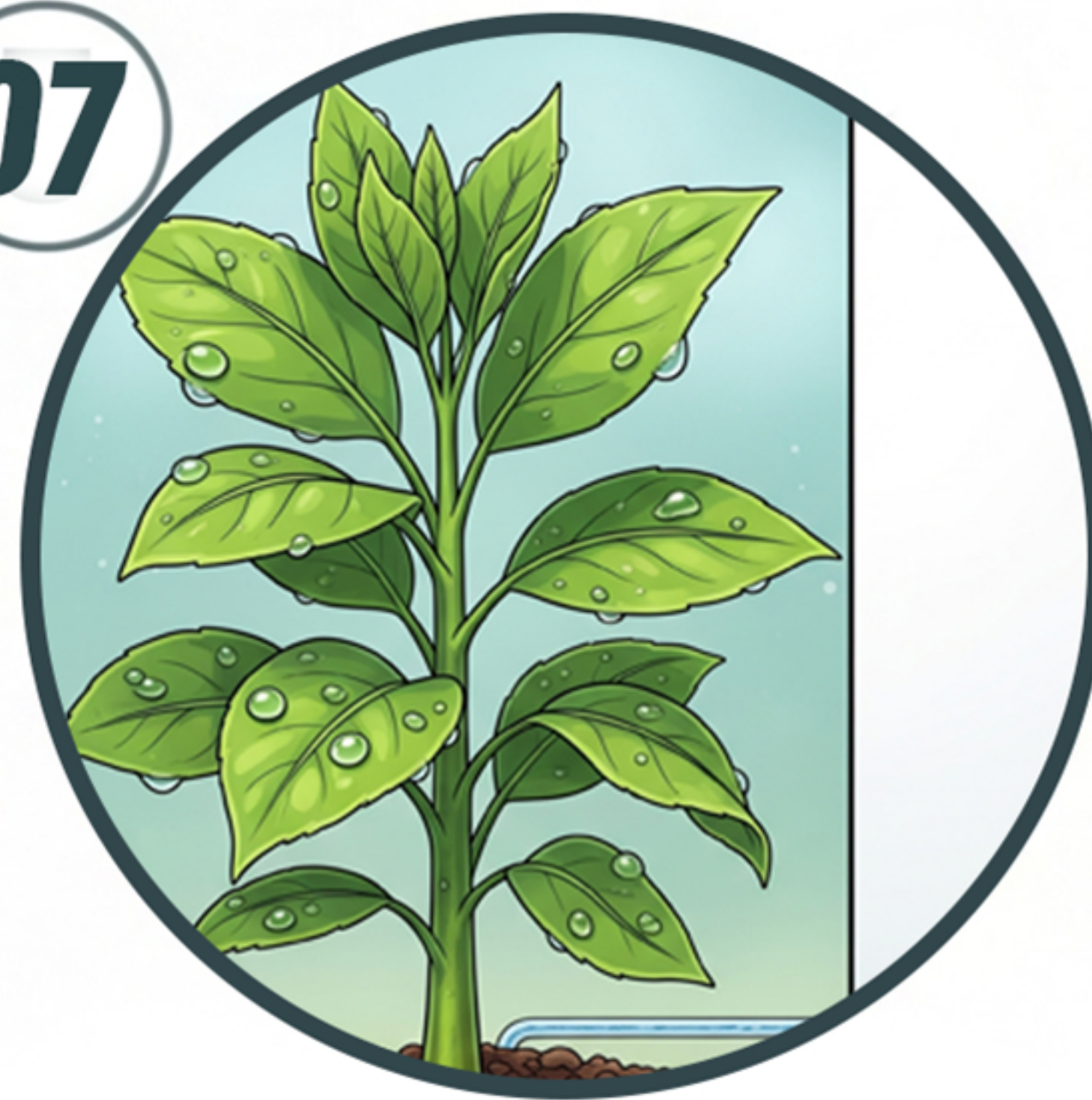

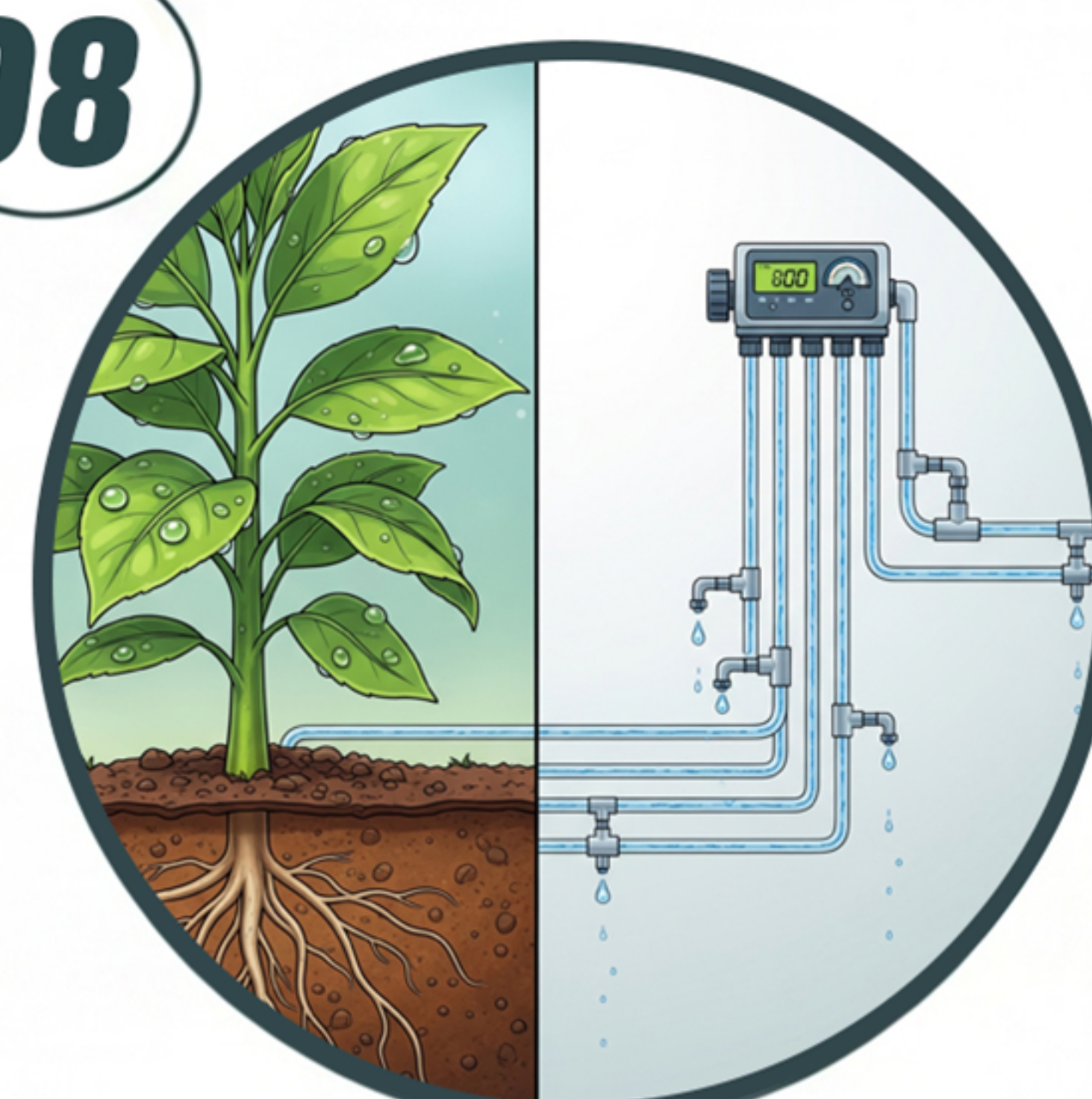
